- Apply certain course credits between programs to satisfy both degree requirements
- Complete the combined degree program within four years as a full-time student
- Pursue a variety of opportunities in hospital leadership and roles including practice owner, clinical director, practice partner, and more

ADMISSION

Applicants seeking admission must meet the requirements for both the College of Health Professions and School of Business. Foundation courses for the MBA begin in May, and students begin physical therapy coursework in August of the following year. International applicants should consult the University catalog for additional requirements.

Doctor of Physical Therapy Admission Requirements

- Bachelor's degree from a regionally accredited institution with a minimum GPA of 3.0
- Completed Physical Therapist Centralized Application
 (PTCAS) application
- · Completed Mercer supplemental application
- \$25 non-refundable supplemental application fee
- Completion of at least six of ten prerequisite courses at the time of application, with a plan for completing remaining courses prior to enrollment*
- GRE scores sent to PTCAS with a minimum combined verbal and quantitative score of 300 (minimum verbal score is 150) and 3.5 for analytical writing
- Minimum of 60 hours of experience in physical therapy settings, with 40 hours of observation or work experience and 20 hours of volunteer experience
- Admissions interview

*Prerequisites include coursework and labs in chemistry, physics, human anatomy and physiology, statistics or biostatistics, biology, psychology, and behavioral science. For additional information, consult the University catalog or visit chp.mercer.edu/admissions/admissions-requirements.
