Program Requirements

- Undergraduate degree requirements have been met with at least 32 semester hours completed at Mercer
- Completed a minimum of statistics and math courses, including STA 126 or MATH 220 and MAT 191, MAT 141, or MATH 130
- Overall GPA of 3.0 GPA at Mercer (including transfer hours), a 3.0 GPA in all business core curriculum courses (if applicable), and a 3.0 GPA in all major courses at Mercer
- Grades of C or above in all business, math, and major coursework at Mercer
